Books and [rehearsal tracks](#) for the **choir cantata**, Silent Night! Holy Night!, are available. The first sing through is November 3 after the worship service.

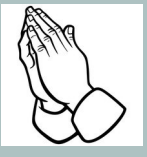


Sunday was a beautiful day for the **Lake Geneva Area CROP Hunger Walk!** We had 20 individuals (including dogs) walk with our church group.
