Take **non-partisan prayer cards** as a prayer tool during election season. Let these reminders help you to focus on Christ and love your neighbors.




Grow Group resumes Wednesday, November 6, 6:30 p.m. We are discussing The Chosen, Season 2. Talk to Pastor Sharon with questions.
